DDA ACTION ITEMS AND UPDATES

Train Horn Quiet Zone Update and Funding

Kevin Tilson gave a brief history of the efforts to put in place a Quiet Zone in Downtown Castle Rock and introduced the current proposal from the Town of Castle Rock and the DDA.

Dave Corliss explained some specifics about the gating system at the Downtown railroad crossings.

UNSCHEDULED PUBLIC COMMENT

Councilmember Johnson supported the project and the use of the Special Fund for the Quiet Zone.

MOTION

Andrew Wasson motioned to spend up to \$900,000 from the Downtown Special Fund to support the implementation of a Train Horn Quiet Zone in the DDA boundaries in Downtown Castle Rock; Josie Adler seconded the motion; the motion carried unanimously by the DDA.
