1. Welcome

Kevin Tilson, Director of the Downtown Alliance greeted everyone and gave a brief description of the DDA, DMA and Downtown Alliance.

2. Introductions

d. Development Projects

- Mirage Dental will be the largest private dental practice in Colorado! From 7 to 37 chairs!
- The Move set to have occupancy summer of 2016. 50,000 SF of employees in Downtown means customers for Downtown businesses.
- Mercantile Commons located at 3rd & Perry St. will be a mixed use development, including residential, and is coming out of the ground now.
- A project is proposed for 221 Wilcox. As proposed it will be a mixed use including residential.
- Riverwalk development, Confluence Company has proposed a mixed use, largely residential, project on either side of Sellers Gulch on Wilcox St.
- There was general discussion about the positive impact of these proposed projects and excitement around the vibrancy that is expected to follow the enhancement of Festival Park and the addition of retail, restaurants, office and residential space in Downtown.

e. Parking

- The Town and DDA are analyzing the needs of the downtown through a parking study.
- We want to know the best solution for our downtown and are currently working to short terms solutions and long term solutions.

f. Festival Park

- DDA and the Town have partnered to enhance Festival Park in order to attract people Downtown to support Downtown businesses and provide a great park for visitors.
